Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to a new school year in 2018! 2017 has been a good year as our students and staff have once again achieved many breakthroughs and sustained successes which are captured in the compilation of our school achievements in our 2017 year book. Many students have also had new and better experiences in their academic learning and CCAs.

School Focus for 2018

We will continue to focus on inculcating the joy of learning, developing the entrepreneurial dare and strengthening the Singapore Spirit in our students, in alignment with MOE's direction. We aim to develop our strengths in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) teaching, supported by our distinctive Aeronautics Applied Learning Programme, inter-disciplinary Project Work with a scientific focus on sustainable living; Science Outdoor Learning Experiential Programme/Elementz Science Research Programme, 'O' level Applied Science Electronics Subject (to be introduced to Sec 3/2019), Fun Math Programme, Craft & Technology 3D Design/Printing Programme etc. Our student development programme will centre on the STAR Programme – <u>Seek out your strength</u>, <u>Take responsibility</u>, <u>Adopt an enterprising spirit</u>, <u>Ready for the world</u>. We will continue to place a strong emphasis on character education, which is anchored by our Character & Citizenship Education programme and our distinctive Learning for Life Programme (LLP) in Community and Youth Leadership - 'Inspired North Stars Inspire Actions'.

2018 Daily Routine, School Calendar and Tests/Exams Schedule

The tests/exams schedule (subject to changes) is to help our students prepare for tests/exams well in advance and do well in them.

Changes in CCA Timing on Fridays

In order to allow students to have more "white space" for self-revision, peer/group study, consultations with teachers or preparing for CCA, as well as to allow teachers to have more time to provide better learning support, the school has decided to revise the CCA timing on Fridays so that most of the CCAs will start at 3.00pm and end by 6.00pm. Correspondingly, the training hours on other days have also been revised. Attached is the new daily routine showing the new CCA timing which will take effect from Friday, 2 Feb 2018. The daily routine on the school website will be updated accordingly.

2018 Sec 1 Intake

We have 8 Sec 1 classes in 2018 – 5 Express, 2 NA and 1 NT classes. We have continued to be a popular school of choice. 93% of our Sec 1 students chose our school as their first 3 choices, with 52% first choice and 32% second choice. The cut-off points for Express, NA and NT courses have all gone up by two points to 210, 174 and 135 respectively.

North Star's Pledge

We have revised our North Star's Pledge to make it more impactful for our students — "I will learn and find my compass; I will excel and strive to go far; I will grow and live a life of purpose; I will shine as I am a North Star!" With effect from 2018, students will recite the pledge after the school song during morning assembly every Monday. With your support, we hope our students will constantly strive to live up to the pledge and be committed to their learning and growth as a good student.

Discipline Matters

• To further tighten late-coming, with immediate effect, students who come to school after **8.30am** without any valid reasons will be stopped at the school gate by the security guards and will not be allowed to enter the school compound. Those who have valid reasons should inform their form teachers in advance or ask their parents/guardians to call the general office for verification. Students who come to school **between 8.00am and 8.30am** without any valid reasons will be allowed to go for lessons but will chalk up two counts of latecoming (Students who come to school between 7.30am and 8.00am will chalk out one count of latecoming). Habitual late-comers (i.e. more than 4 times late per semester) will be disciplined and counselled. Disciplinary measures include detention class after school and/or suspension from class/school. Students who are late more than 8 times in a year may receive a conduct grade no better than "Good".

• Students are not allowed to modify the cutting or length of their school shorts/pants, skirts or PE shorts without good reasons. Those found breaking the school rules on attire will be asked to rectify their attire or purchase a new pair of attire. Recalcitrant students may be suspended from lessons or school until they comply with the school rules.

<u>Highlights of School Programmes in Term 4/2017</u>

- Leadership Development and Cultural Immersion trip to Hong Kong (19-25 Nov) 39 students from our 5 uniformed group and various sports CCAs went on this trip which included 3 hiking trails that challenged the students' physical and endurance limits and built resilience and team spirit. The students also visited a junior high school and various cultural/educational attractions.
- Performing Arts and Cultural Immersion trip to Hangzhou/Suzhou/Shanghai (29 Oct-5 Nov) 40 students from our 4 performing arts CCAs went on this trip which included a visit to an arts school, attending an arts enrichment workshop, viewing world class international/Chinese arts/cultural performances, and visits to our two twinning schools in Suzhou and various cultural/educational attractions.
- Aeronautics/vocational learning journey to Beijing/Tianjin (19-26 Nov) 37 students went on this trip and visited various aeronautical/vocational schools and the industry, secondary schools with a niche in aeronautics and various cultural/educational attractions.
- Sec 2 Interdisciplinary Project Work all Sec 2 students completed their project work on biodiversity conservation or energy sustainability as they studied future challenges to sustainable living. The first group went through the biodiversity trail in Hort Park and then designed similar trails in their neighbourhoods. The second group studied the use of solar energy in a workshop conducted by Temasek Polytechnic and went on to design household devices which worked on renewable sources of energy. The projects were then showcased at Project Work Carnival during post-exam period.
- Arts@KK Women's and Children's Hospital 138 members from our 4 performing arts CCA groups performed for patients, visitors and staff at KKH on 25 Oct. The event was featured on KKH's Facebook with a big 'thank you' to all our young performers.
